Yet with all of these varying factors there is <u>only one</u> theme throughout the entire Bible! This is one of the most powerful evidences that this book was written by God. God's only theme is His plan for mankind. So let's look at God's plan for us.

Gospel means good news.



What is this good news?

The Gospel (good news) is the message of how mankind can be saved. Apostle Paul said...



"I am not ashamed of the gospel for it is the power of God for salvation..."

Romans 1:16




The Gospel...Must be Obeyed

A Warning...To Christians


"I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him who called you by the grace of Christ, for a different gospel; which is really not another; only there are some who are disturbing you and want to distort the gospel of Christ. But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach a gospel other than the one we preached to you, let him be eternally condemned!"

Galatians 1:6-12 (see also Acts 20:28)

However, the gospel is often misunderstood by Christians thinking there are many gospels. Apostle Paul said. (^) So we see if we miss obeying the gospel (good news) of how to be saved that in the end it <u>will not matter</u> how religious or good we were. This is why there is a different church at every corner. People are sincere in their belief. However, it does not matter what we think, but God. This is not a politically correct statement in today's world of everyone can believe what they want.

The ONE Gospel





Well the old law in the Old Testament taught us how we can be brought to Christ through faith. So let's look at this to help us understand the gospel or good news.



"Thus you are to be holy to Me, for I the LORD am holy; and I have set you apart from the peoples to be Mine." Lev. 20:26

God is Holy! There is no impurity in Him. God requires us to also be holy.



"For the word of the LORD is upright, And all His work is done in faithfulness. He loves righteousness and justice; The earth is full of the loving kindness of the LORD."

JUSTICE

LOVE

God's holiness is demonstrated in His justice and love toward mankind.

^ If we only experienced the JUSTICE of God it would be a short story for all of us. However, the other side of His holiness is His LOVE. He gives us a way to redeem ourselves.





However, God is Holy, but we are not always so holy. The Bible says that our sins separate us from having a relationship with God.



Whoever is born of God does not sin. 1John 5:18

Romans 6:23for the wages of sin is death



Romans 3:23 ... for all have sinned

So we need somehow for our sing to be dealt with so we can have a relationship with God.

^ Our eternal spiritual bodies are dead inside us even though our earthly physical body is alive.

The **PRICE** for SIN



How can it be dealt with? What is the price for sin? It is life. Life must be given.



God's Justice Demands Death as Payment for Sin



That places all of us in a desperate situation since we have all sinned.

We all have the price of death hanging over our heads.

How are we suppose to pay that price?



God's Love Provides a Way to Pay the Price

GRACE

God *gives*what is *not* deserved (Romans 3:23-26; 5:6-11)


MERCY

God *does not give* what *is* deserved (Romans 1:18)


LIFE!

However, to obtain this grace and mercy in the Old Testament one had to sacrifice an animal. So by **acting** on their belief the blood of that animal's life is how forgiveness was obtained.



To summarize. In the Old Testament a sinner deserved to die. However, he didn't have to die. The sinner could offer an animal that would die in his place. So his sins were transferred figuratively to the innocent animal and his sins could be dealt with in the death of that animal. So the sinner representatively died when the animal died.

So through this process he was forgiven and made holy and could then have a relationship with God.



So what made animal sacrifice work? Was it just superstition? Ritual? Tradition? No, it was <u>faith</u>. In fact faith is behind any act of obedience that we do like. For example taking medicine. (Explain)



Just like Noah acted on his faith and he built the ark and all these other examples in the Bible. Genuine faith requires **action**.


BELIEF ALONE?(James 2:14-26)

(v14) Can just faith save a man?
(v17) Faith without action is dead
(v18) Faith is shown by action
(v20) Faith without action is "useless"
(v24) Justified by action, not "faith alone"
(v26) Faith without action is dead
(v19) Devils are believers!


There are believers in eternal punishment!




The Bible tells us more about faith. When it ask can belief alone save us? (^)




So we learn a lot looking at the Old Testament. Now let's look at the new law in the New Testament which we are under today.



In the New Testament <u>Jesus</u> is referred to as the Lamb of God that takes away the sin of the world.



Jesus is the one final offering for all sin for all time. In Jesus there is no sin. He is an innocent and blameless sacrifice. He came to give his life for the forgiveness of our sins. Jesus paid the price for us.



So when we sin we deserve death, but we don't have to die because Jesus died for us and (this is the key) when we <u>die with Jesus</u> our sins can be dealt with and forgiven and we can be free from sin and made holy.



"I have been crucified with Christ and it is no longer I wno live, but Christ lives in me"

Galatians 2:20



"crucified with Christ"




Christ's death represents the death of the believer!

(^) So if we want to live with him then our old selves has to <u>die with him</u>. If we want to be saved then our old life we lived before obeying Christ has to be <u>crucified with Christ</u>. Christ's death represents the death of our old selves so we can start a new life as a follower of Christ.





We have died with Christ. Then we die to sin.



This is according to the plan of redemption for "without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins."



The fundamental question of the gospel is:


When?

At what point in my faith . . .

do I die to sin?
do I die with Christ?

When does God view me as . . .

uniting with Christ in his death? crucified with Christ?



Some think we can just go on sinning if we have God's grace, but we died to sin so we can't live in it any longer. So again how or when do we die to sin?

What Shall We Do?

Now when they heard this, they were pierced to the heart,

and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles,

"Brethren, what shall we do?"




(^) This is where much of the misunderstanding comes from today. How does the gospel **in the Bible** say we die to sin?






(^) What do you do with dead people? You **<u>bury</u>** them. You wouldn't just sprinkle or pour over them. Then they are raised from the watery grave of baptism to walk a new life.





(^) That is the only way that our sin can be dealt with.

That is the only way we can be saved and the only way to die with Christ is to be buried in baptism.



So that is the big picture of the Bible.

I believe this and I have died with Christ in baptized and that is why I am motivated to share God's plan to others.

So what is your response to this gospel or good news?

Would you allow me to baptize you into Christ now? So that you can die with Him and arise to walk in a new life having Christ's Blood applied to your account in heaven?
